Dear Ms. Olds:

This office represents Albert Poet, M.D. By this letter, Dr. Poet supplements his previous response to the government's subpoena. The following documents, utilizing the previously established pagination system, are enclosed, with the following explanations:

- 2064-2170. These documents include paper billing cards for those patients of my client of relatively long standing for which such billing cards were maintained. Also contained within this group are Quick Books-generated "statements" and "receipts", setting forth the status of the patient's account. To be noted, however, is that to the best of my client's knowledge, neither the statement nor receipt documents were tendered to patients as statements or receipts; this is merely the format utilized by the software program in generating the data stored on my client's computer network in readable format.
- 2171-2568. These are similar Quick Books-generated statement and receipt documents for patients for whom my client did not maintain billing cards, which are the majority. Again, these documents were not provided to patients as statements or receipts.
