Thank you for your letter of October 11, 2006. The government has produced at this time all materials it believes fall within the requirements of the Court's Discovery order and *Brady v. Maryland* and will continue to supplement discovery if and when it receives additional materials subject to disclosure.

The government is well aware of its responsibility to review for *Brady* disclosure materials within the possession of other government entities and is not aware of any non-disclosed materials which could prove exculpatory or relevant in the present case. The government's position is that information stemming from the investigation of Toxin Research International ("TRI"), other than that information, previously disclosed, which directly relates to the sales of TRI's product to Dr. Poet, is irrelevant to the case at hand. Nevertheless, in an effort to assist with your request, please find enclosed a CD containing interviews conducted in relation to the investigation of TRI throughout the United States.
