Diana F [REDACTED] was telephonically contacted at 973/[REDACTED] at her place of employment, [REDACTED] [REDACTED], Fairfield, New Jersey 07004. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing agent and the nature of the interview, Rice provided the following information:

F [REDACTED] received Botox treatments from Dr. Albert Poet at Montclair, New Jersey. She knew of Poet prior to becoming a patient because he advertised his medical practice in the newspaper for which she is an Account Executive, The Suburban Essex.

F [REDACTED] was asked about advertisements run by Poet in the Suburban Essex but refused to answer.

F [REDACTED] further advised that she was aware of the indictment and arrest of Poet and considered this investigation to be "bogus".

F [REDACTED] further advised that she had complete trust in Poet and did not wish to participate in the interview. F [REDACTED] did indicate that she liked Poet and had no complaint concerning medical procedures which he provided. F [REDACTED] further advised that she sees no difference between the FDA approved Botox cosmetic drug and the Toxin Research International (TRI) drug because the TRI drug was an "unapproved generic".

F [REDACTED] advised that she intended to send the interviewing agent an email with her further views on this matter.
